

PRESENTATION

The MolokaBRA Downwind is a nautical sports competition held in the northeast of Brazil, in the State of Ceará, known worldwide as the land of winds.

It brings together several types of paddle and canoeing sports (stand up paddle, SUP Foil, paddleboard, surfski, outrigger canoe and sailing canoe)

It is organized by the Stand Up Paddle Association of Ceará (ASUPCE) and in 2025 it will hold its seventh edition bringing together sportsmen from all over Brazil and abroad.

The geographical position of the State of Ceará and the strong winds (more than 25 knots), constant and aligned with the continent provide the best downwind condition in Brazil, being also considered one of the best in the world, favoring the realization of nautical downwind events paddlesports and sailing modalities, such as kitesurfing, whose world record for the largest number of sailors sailing together occurred in the state with official registration in the Guinness Book.

PRESENTATION

The sea of the State of Ceará is perfect for high performance. Over the six previous editions (2019 – 2024), we have already received great names in the world of paddlesports, such as Tupuria King from New Zealand, Oscar Chaluspsky from South Africa and Greg Barton from the USA, in addition to state and Brazilian champion athletes, which attests to the great attractiveness of the event, not only due to the possibility of high performance but also for the fun on the ocean bumps of the green seas of Ceará,

In addition to the excellent conditions of sea, wind, current and mild temperatures all year round, the State of Ceará has a strong tourist bias, with almost 600km of coastline, which positions it as one of the main tourist destinations in Brazil, endowed with a hotel network of the highest quality standard to provide an extremely pleasant and attractive stay for all participants.

The competition takes place over a week, interspersing official training, official competitions and free days for tourism, leisure, rest and also parallel activities for the training of athletes (lectures, courses and clinics).

Usually the event is planned well in advance, favoring the participation of athletes and logistical issues related to air tickets, accommodation, rental and transportation of equipment.

TEST SYSTEM

The MolokaBRA Downwind 2025 consists of 3 stages held on 08/25, 08/27 and 08/29, all of 30km. On August 23rd there will be an official training open to all registered athletes and under equal conditions of the official races, an opportunity for everyone to familiarize themselves with the local downwind conditions, which are quite specific.

ORGANISER

Stand Up Paddle Association of Ceará (ASUPCE), a local sports entity that covers rowing sports with 14 years of activities completed in 2025 and that over the years has contributed to the enhancement of paddle and canoeing sports in the State of Ceará, in addition to the organization of local and national events as well as being the founder of the local Vaa Federation (FEVAACE).

PRESENT MODALITIES

Stand Up Paddle, SUP Foil, Paddleboard, Surfski, Outrigger Canoe (V1, V1R and V3) and Sailing Canoe

START DATE AND END DATE

MolokaBRA Downwind 2025 starts on August 22nd and ends on August 31st, encompassing, in addition to the official training and the races, an opening ceremony, a schedule of training activities, tourism activities, awards and social parties after the races.

CITIES / STATE

Municipalities of Fortaleza and Caucaia (Praia de Cumbuco), located on the west coast of the State of Ceará, Northeast region of Brazil.
